



SAPEC EQUIPMENT WILL UNDERTAKE MEDIANETWORK PERU CONTRIBUTIONS

Madrid (16 Febrero 2011).

SAPEC, Spanish company specialized in solutions for transmission of video and audio signals, supplied the video encoders and decoders that will be making the contributions among MediaNetwork's facilities via PDH network by means of its distributor in Peru, **RIO PACIFICO**,

SAPEC encoders will compress 6 programs in Lima headquarter, providing one PDH (E3) output to be distributed into 3 PDH frames. These frames will link Lima headquarter with the seven MediaNetwork's facilities spread over Peru.

The main operator in Peru trusted again the reliability of **SAPEC** equipment. Similar equipment is currently making the contributions from football stadiums to MediaNetwork's headquarter.

The units supplied belong to the **SIVAC 2000** family of encoders and decoders that allows up to 4 encoding/decoding boards in a 2RU chassis with AC and DC redundant power supply.



One of the key aspects in choosing **SAPEC** equipment is the low encoding and decoding delay introduced by the units (less than 140 ms) and the enhanced PDH output interface, that allows to chain several programs into E3 / DS3 without using an external PDH multiplexer.

The management and control of the units will be performed via web page, SNMP and the **SIVAC NMS-1000** management software developed by **SAPEC**, which allows a total integrated real-time control.
